Requirements

ARRT registration must be current and in good standing. Thorough knowledge of radiographic protocols and procedures.

Must meet continuing education requirements

Able to use clinic practice management and electronic health record software and have a working knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel

Abide by HIPAA guidelines at all times.

Essential Functions

Must be able to take quality radiographs of patients per ordering physician's request.

Has working knowledge of equipment and maintains as able. Responsible for coordinating routine servicing as well as repair requests with equipment vendor(s).

Maintains PACS system and Dosimeters

Work with BSU athletic trainers and athletes to provide x-ray services requested by physicians during training room visits in an efficient manner.

Cover NCAA Required Boise State University Athletic Events as well as Boise State University home football games.

Provides x-ray services for Fall Weekend Injury Clinic

Provides imaging discs or imaging prints for patients, outgoing referrals and medical records requests.

Orders supplies

Assists physician extenders and physicians as needed.

Aids with marketing and special events as needed.

Performs other duties as assigned.
